Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2025 RDX EPS Software Update

On September 5, 2025, Acura notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for certain 2025 RDX vehicles due to a software programming issue that may deactivate Electric Power Steering (EPS) assist, cause steering difficulty, and illuminate the "STOP. Steering Assist Reduced. Stop Driving When Safe." warning indicator, increasing the risk of a crash or injury. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Update the EPS control unit software.

SOFTWARE

The updated software will be available at launch.

PARTS

There are no parts needed for this recall.

TOOLS

There are no new special tools needed for this recall.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 25-047, *Safety Recall: 2025 RDX EPS Software Update* posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of September 6, 2025. It includes software repair and warranty claim information related to this recall.

CLIENT NOTIFICATION

Acura expects to begin client notification in mid-October 2025.
