**From:** Product Safety & Certification**Subject:** Recall RVXX2507, Trailer Lights Inoperative**Description of Defect:**

Certain Volvo New VNs may be equipped with a trailer body input output module that controls lighting functions for the trailer being towed. These vehicles may contain a manufacturing defect. This defect could cause the module to have limited functionality, rendering the trailer lights inoperable and increasing the risk of a crash. If a trailer being towed experiences a loss of trailer lighting functions, vehicles around the trailer may not observe the trailer reducing speed, stopping, or changing lanes, which could lead to an increased risk of a crash.

**Models/ Model Years Affected:**

Certain MY 2025-2026 New VN vehicles manufactured from October 14, 2024 through September 5 2025.

**Vehicle Quantities:**

2,549 (2,307 US, 242 Canada, 0 Mexico and 0 Export)

**Dealer's Responsibility:**

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

**Release Schedule:**

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 9/25/2025.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 11/17/2025.
- Repair instructions will be released once they are available.
