



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – A2C

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2020 through 2025 Model Year (GA) Alfa Romeo Giulia and 2020 through 2025 Model Year (GU) Alfa Romeo Stelvio vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a Printed Circuit Board (PCB) defect and/or a software defect, which may result in the rearview image not displaying in a backing event. Failure to display a rearview image can increase the risk of a crash.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.111 S6.2.6 requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible and meet the requirements of FMVSS No. 571.111 S6.2.1 (field of view) and S6.2.2 (image size) at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected." Suspect vehicles may not display the rearview image during a backing event under certain conditions.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to inspect the radio, and if necessary, replace it with a radio at the latest software level. If the radio passes inspection, a software update will be performed. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2025.
