Re: **STOP SALE NOTICE: CB1000 #1 - GEAR SHIFT PEDAL PIVOT BOLT**

Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is issuing a **STOP SALE NOTICE** on **CERTAIN 2025 CB1000SP** motorcycles. Due to a manufacturing defect, the pivot bolt securing the gear shift pedal to the body frame may loosen and fall out while riding. If the gear shift pedal separates from the body frame, the operator will be unable to shift gears while riding, increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

AFFECTED UNITS

Certain 2025 CB1000SP motorcycles:

- To search for applicable recalls on a specific unit, you **MUST** use *Unit Information* on **iN**, available October 20, 2025.
- To manage your affected inventory, use your dealer *eResponsibility Report* on **iN**, available October 20, 2025.

SERVICE BULLETIN

CB1000SP #1, which includes all the information relating to this Safety Recall, is expected to be issued in mid November 2025.

PARTS INFORMATION

Parts needed for the repair are expected in mid November 2025 and can be ordered according to the instructions in the forthcoming Service Bulletin. Dealers will be notified by *iN* message once parts become available.

FLOORING SUPPORT

Due to the delayed availability of parts, American Honda will issue a one month prepaid flooring credit for all new, unregistered 2025 CB1000SP motorcycles in dealer inventory. Complete information for flooring support will be provided to dealers via *iN* message soon.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda intends to mail customer letters to all owners of affected motorcycles in December 2025. Customers will be informed that their motorcycle is affected by this safety-related defect and to make an appointment with an authorized Honda dealer to have their unit repaired.

Make sure all departments in your dealership are aware of this Safety Recall.
