Certain Volvo VAH vehicles may be equipped with a fixed passenger seat belt anchor that does not meet requirements for FMVSS 210 S4.2 due to inadequate floor reinforcement.

In the event of a crash, the passenger seat belt anchor to the floor may fail, increasing the risk of injury.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain MY 2019-2026 VAH vehicles manufactured from November 2, 2018 through May 26, 2025 .

Vehicle Quantities:

261 (242 US, 19 Canada, 0 Mexico and 0 Export)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 11/10/2025.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 1/2/2026.
- Repair instructions will be released once they are available.
