Ref: NHTSA 24V-800 Software error may cause grabber fingers to move unintentionally

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

McNeilus has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2024-2025 McNeilus Volterra ZSL vehicles have software that will allow unintentional movement of the side collection grabber arm without operator input.

! I M P O R T A N T !

- Your McNeilus vehicle is being recalled.

Why is a recall being conducted?

When the fingers of the grabber arm are closing, the fingers extend beyond the side of the vehicle. If the fingers of the grabber arm move unexpectedly, they could strike people or objects in the vicinity of the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

What are we doing about the problem?

McNeilus will send technicians to customer trucks free of charge to update the software version which is intended to prevent any unintended motion of the grabber arm. This will be done at no cost to the customer.
