Subject: RVXX2512 Load Lock Clamps

Description of Defect:

Certain Volvo VNL(4)s are equipped with load lock clamps on the back of the cab that may experience breakage due to early life failures. Load lock clamp failures may result in load lock bars being unsecured during vehicle operation. Loose or unsecured load lock bars may cause injury or increase the risk of a crash.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2023-2026 VNL (4) model vehicles manufactured from 10/02/2023, through 10/14//2025.

Vehicle Quantities:

2,391 (1,859 US, 532 Canada, 0 Mexico and 0 Export)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 11/27/2025.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 1/15/2026.
- Repair instruction will be released once they are available.
