



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – B8C

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2025 and 2026 model year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup vehicles equipped with a 12" Instrument Panel Cluster (sales code JAN).

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a 12" instrument panel cluster (IPC) containing software that causes the cluster to go blank at start up or while driving. A Malfunction Indicator Light (MIL) may illuminate prior to IPC failure to display. An IPC that does not display critical safety information, such as the BRAKE system warning lights, can increase the risk of a crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No 571.135 which requires an indicator lamp be activated in the event of brake system malfunction. Vehicles with a blank IPC cannot display the brake system warning light.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the IPC. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2025.
