



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – D4C

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2024 model year Alfa Romeo Giulia Quadrifoglio (QV) vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a misrouted headlamp wire harness that may become damaged and disable a headlamp. A nonfunctional headlamp can reduce forward visibility which can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 571.108 S6.1.1 specifies the number of lamps and/or reflective devices for these suspect vehicles and their conformance to the performance requirements of this standard. The damaged harness may cause the headlamps not to function.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to inspect the wheel arch liner, and replace if necessary, and inspect the wire harness and re-route and/or repair if necessary. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 1st Quarter of 2026.
