Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2016-2020 ILX Brake Master Cylinder

On December 11, 2025, Acura notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for certain model year 2016-2020 ILX units. Brake master cylinders may have been manufactured with components which can contaminate the brake fluid and cause swelling, possibly leading to leaking seals. These leaks could lead to diminished, or a loss of, braking function, potentially increasing the risk of a crash or injury. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

**REPAIR**

Replace the brake master cylinder assembly.

**PARTS**

Due to limited availability, parts are not available for dealer order at this time. If you have a client experiencing this symptom, please contact your DPSPM.

**TOOLS**

There are no special tools needed for this recall.

**SERVICE BULLETIN**

Service Bulletin 25-055, *Safety Recall: 2016-20 ILX Brake Master Cylinder* posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of December 12, 2025. It includes parts, repair, and warranty claim information related to this recall.

**CLIENT NOTIFICATION**

Acura expects to begin client notification by the beginning of February 2026.
