Re: **STOP SALE NOTICE: CB1000SP #2 – ENGINE OIL CONSUMPTION**

Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is issuing a **STOP SALE NOTICE** on **CERTAIN 2025 CB1000SP** motorcycles due to an engine oil consumption concern. If the engine oil level is not checked frequently enough, the oil level may drop low enough to damage internal engine components. If the motorcycle continues to operate with a low engine oil level, the engine could seize, causing it to stall while riding and potentially increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

AFFECTED UNITS

Certain 2025 CB1000SP motorcycles:

- To search for applicable recalls on a specific unit, you **MUST** use *Unit Information* on *iN*, available December 16, 2025.
- To manage your affected inventory, use your dealer *eResponsibility Report* on *iN*, available December 16, 2025.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service bulletin CB1000 #2, which includes all information relating to this Safety Recall, will be revised to include all parts and repair information. Dealers will be notified by *iN* message.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda intends to mail customer letters to all owners of affected motorcycles in February 2026. Customers will be informed that their motorcycle is affected by this safety-related defect and to make an appointment with an authorized Honda dealer to have their unit repaired.

Make sure all departments in your dealership are aware of this Safety Recall.
