IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle(s):

[1N9APB1A3N2393XXX]

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nikola Corporation has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2024-2025 Tre FCEV trucks manufactured from 8/30/23 to 09/16/2024. The trucks may have been manufactured with incorrect hydrogen tank mounting block bolts that are longer than those designed for the vehicle. Hydrogen tank block mounting bolts that are too long could contact the hydrogen tank, potentially causing damage, increasing the risk of a leak which increases the risk of a fire.

Nikola will inspect the hydrogen tank mounting bolts in your truck. Incorrect bolts will be replaced and any tanks that have damage will be also replaced at no cost to you. You should contact Nikola Corporation, (888) 268-1181 or service@nikolamotor.com, as soon as possible to arrange for the inspection and potential replacement. The initial inspection process takes about 30 minutes. If necessary, replacing the bolts takes about 30 minutes and replacing the tank takes about 6 hours. All trucks affected by this recall are under warranty. If you have paid for repairs for this issue prior to receiving this notice, you are eligible for a refund. Any lessor who receives this notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Federal law requires that you forward a copy of this safety recall notice to the lessee within 10 days.
