This is an important Safety Recall. The remedy will be performed FREE OF CHARGE to you.

**Certain 2023 Model Year Porsche 911 Vehicles
Porsche Recall ASAO / NHTSA ID 25V-078**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain specific 2023 Porsche 911 vehicles.

What is the issue?

Porsche recently determined that the rear seat belt buckles may not be bolted to design specifications and could potentially loosen over time. If the bolts loosen, the rear seat belts may not perform as designed in the event of a crash, increasing a risk of injury.

What will Porsche do?

To remedy this issue, your Porsche Center will check the affected seat belt bolts, and if necessary, replace them **at no charge to you**. The remedy will take approximately one hour to complete, but it may be necessary to make your vehicle available to your Porsche Center for a longer period of time. Your Porsche Center will arrange for alternate transportation if necessary.

What should you do?
Please contact any authorized Porsche dealer to schedule an appointment to have this recall performed as soon as possible and to arrange for Porsche-provided alternate transportation, if necessary.
