Dear Winnebago Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Winnebago has decided that certain 2025 Access and Voyage travel trailers that fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110, "Tire Selection and Rims." Our records indicate that you have purchased a vehicle with the serial number which appears above.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

On certain 2025 Winnebago Access and Voyage travel trailers the Federal Identification Label and Tire Loading Information Placard has the incorrect tire inflation listed. These vehicles were produced **April 18, 2024** through **December 18, 2024**.

Incorrect tire inflation information can result in improperly inflated tires and cause tire failure, increasing the risk of a crash.

WHAT WE WILL DO

On affected vehicles, Winnebago will provide customers with a new corrected label and installation instructions. The customers will also have the option to utilize a dealer for installation. The time necessary to complete the repair will be approximately 30 minutes. Please allow additional time for the dealer to process your vehicle. **This repair will be done at no charge to you.**

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Follow the enclosed instructions for installation of the new labels. After the new labels are installed, please return the supplied pre-paid post card, or send pictures of new vin tags on the sidewall to retailwoi@wgo.net If you have any questions, please contact us at retailwoi@wgo.net or at (574) 825-5250.

Should you prefer having the dealership complete the recall, please contact your Winnebago Towables dealer to arrange for an appointment. To locate the nearest Winnebago of Indiana dealer, you can visit

Presentation of this letter to the service center will assist in making the necessary correction to your vehicle more efficient.

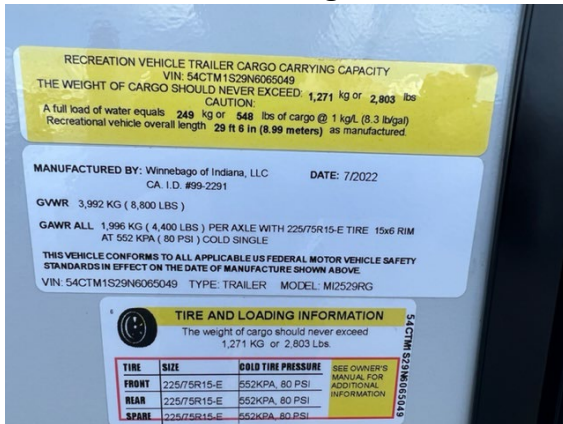

Step 1.

Clean the area and wipe dry. Once surface is prepped and dried apply new tags.
