**SUBJECT:** Brakes May Engage Unexpectedly and Overheat

**Ref:** NHTSA 25V279

Attention Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Temsa Skoda Sabancı Ulaşım Araçları A.S. (Temsa) is Temsa has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2021-2025 TS30, TS35, and 2021-2026 TS45 buses equipped with a Mux5-B multiplex. The temporary bus stop valve may activate unintentionally and apply the brakes, causing them to overheat. Brakes that overheat can increase the risk of a fire.

Temsa will inspect the multiplex, update the software, and repair the wiring harness as necessary, free of charge. Temsa estimates that it will take 110 minutes to inspect and repair each affected vehicle. Temsa records indicate that you are the owner or operator of the following vehicle(s) included in this recall:
