This notice applies to your vehicle: «Truck_VIN»

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Orange EV (OEV) has decided that certain 2023-2025 HUSK-e terminal trucks contain a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety. In these vehicles the High Voltage thermal fuse may not provide adequate protection in the event of a short circuit or electrical surge and may increase the risk of a thermal event or fire.

Our records indicate that you are the current owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the Condition?

The contactors on the High Voltage thermal fuse may not open and could become welded together if there is a short circuit or electrical surge.

What Will Orange EV Do?

Orange EV will remove the existing High Voltage thermal fuse and will replace it with a fuse that provides appropriate short circuit protection

What Should You Do?

Please contact your Regional Service Supervisor to schedule this repair. We anticipate parts will be available beginning on or around June 13, 2025.

What if you are not the owner or operator of this vehicle?

If you are a vehicle lessor, Federal Law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you know the current owner or operator, please forward this letter to them.
