IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 25510

NHTSA RECALL NO. 25V503

THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO YOUR VEHICLE IDENTIFIED ON THE ENCLOSED CARD.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2016 thru 2024 IC Bus™ CE school buses built 6/4/2015 thru 12/14/2023 with feature codes 0004198, 0004240 (Brake system, hydraulic with Hydromax brake booster).

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The brake pressure switch may allow brake fluid to seep past the diaphragm seal into the brake pressure switch electrical connector and associated fuse which can short the switch and/or fuse.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

A shorted switch or fuse may cause the circuit to generate excessive heat which can result in a fire, increasing the risk of property damage or personal injury to the operator.

DEFECT REMEDY

You may already have been contacted about a similar Safety Recall 23518 (NHTSA 23V-398) in 2023. Any vehicle remedied under that recall also requires this recall remedy to be performed.

Vehicles will have a new brake pressure switch/fuse harness installed that contains an anti-capillary wire that will block fluid from wicking up the copper.

The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 1.5 hours to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

Until the remedy can be performed, vehicle owners are advised to park their vehicles outdoors.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your

vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 06/04/2015 thru 12/31/2025. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
