Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2024 thru 2026 IC Bus™ CE Series school buses built 09/21/2023 thru 07/28/2025 with feature code 0004100 (Hydraulic Brakes) and without 0004GAS (Powered Park Brake).

IC Bus requests your prompt attention and patience regarding the correction of this defect and apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause you.

REASON FOR THIS EMISSIONS RECALL

The park brake tension spring was not coated properly allowing the spring to corrode and/or fracture.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Corrosion of the park brake tension spring may reduce pressure in the parking brake assembly resulting in a vehicle unexpectedly moving, increasing the risk of property damage or personal injury.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve replacing the forward parking brake cable and adjusting the parking brake. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately one hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 09/21/2023 thru 10/31/2025. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE
