## ! IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL !

### ENGINE OIL DIPSTICK REPLACEMENT

**Safety Recall:** SRAN640  
**NHTSA Recall:** 25V531

**This notice applies to your motorcycle:**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Triumph Motorcycles Ltd. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your motorcycle, with the VIN shown above. Triumph is conducting a safety recall to address the condition.

**The reason for this recall notice:** The engine may degrade prematurely and fail due to internal damage. Engine failure increases the risk of a crash, especially during high demand driving conditions.

**What Triumph Motorcycles Ltd & your dealer will do:** Triumph Motorcycle Ltd. will increase the engine oil capacity and install a redesigned dipstick to ensure accurate oil level measurement, free of charge to you including parts and labor. This repair should take less than 10 minutes. However, depending upon the dealer's work schedule, it may be necessary to make your motorcycle available for a longer period.

**What you must do to ensure your safety:** Please make an appointment with your authorized Triumph motorcycles dealer to have this important remedy performed on your motorcycle as soon as possible.

**Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within 10 days.**

**If you need help:** Please contact your authorized Triumph dealer should you have any questions or encounter any difficulty regarding this recall. In the event your dealer is unable to remedy your motorcycle, in the first instance please contact Triumph Motorcycles America at 1-678-854-2010.

If your dealer fails or is unable to remedy this defect without charge, or within a reasonable amount of time, you may submit a written complaint to Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE., Washington, D.C., 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <https://www.nhtsa.gov>.
