**Re: Reading Truck, LLC Safety Recall
AT&T BSW Trucks with Curt Hitch 15400**

Dear Mr. [Redacted]:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Reading Truck, LLC has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2023 Ram 4500 vehicles with the following Unit Numbers and Vehicle Identification Numbers (VIN):

Reading has identified an issue of incorrect installation process for units completed at the Reading Truck manufacturing facility in Reading, PA that included a Curt part number 15400 with a 2" receiver hitch. Investigation has concluded that only (4) of the required (6) mounting points for the hitch to be fastened to the OEM chassis frame were utilized during installation. This issue may expose the vehicle owner, operator or other persons to the risk of death or serious bodily injury in the event of a failure of the installed component, which can also increase the risk of a crash.

Reading has identified the locations of all (10) units in the field that will require repair. If any of the above units are in service, the vehicle should immediately be taken out of service or quarantined until repairs are complete. If any unit is not in service, it should remain out of service until Reading can arrange the necessary repair. The remedy is to replace the hitch. The repair will take approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes to complete.



Please notify personnel who have control and authority to quarantine these vehicles. To arrange repairs, please contact:

If you no longer own this vehicle, or it has been removed from operation permanently, please inform the undersigned.

If you had this corrective action performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
