IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

NHTSA Recall # 25V-627

This applies to your vehicles, see attached VIN listing.

Dear Valued Wabash Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Wabash National Corporation (WNC) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2025-2026 model Brenner Tank Trailers equipped with incorrect internal and outlet valves.

A complete listing of trailers impacted by this recall is included with this letter.

Description of Defect:

The internal valve and outlet valve on the subject vehicles did not have Teflon coated discs. Consequently, the valves may be susceptible to internal corrosion and damage when used with certain types of fluids, which could cause a leak.

Risk to Motor Vehicle Safety:

Leaks of certain hazardous products from the internal and outlet valves may increase the risk of personal injury to people in the vicinity of the tank.

Precautions You Should Take:

Visually inspect both valves for leaks before operating the vehicle. Before complete failure of the valve would occur, a damaged valve would leak around the butterfly shaft. A fluid leak may be detected visibly or by the presence of an odor.

Remedy:

We are pleased to inform you that a remedy is available now! Wabash will replace both the internal and outlet valves with ones lined internally with Teflon. The equipment listed within should be remedied as soon as practical. This repair should take approximately 6 hours and will be performed at no cost to the owner. The owner may perform this recall and be reimbursed by Wabash in accordance with our standard reimbursement policy, or you may contact your nearest Wabash Warranty Provider and schedule the repair with them. If Already Remedied:

If this repair has been performed at cost to the owner prior to receipt of this notification, the owner may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
