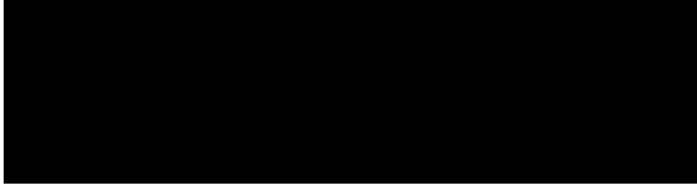

URGENT SAFETY RECALL

This is an important Safety Recall. The remedy will be performed **FREE OF CHARGE** to you.

Certain 2024-2026 Model Year Porsche Panamera and Cayenne Vehicles
Porsche Recall ASA9 / NHTSA ID 25V-634

Dear :

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2024-2026 model year Porsche Panamera and Porsche Cayenne vehicles.

What is the issue?

Porsche recently determined that on certain specific vehicles, that the high-pressure fuel pump may not have been tightened to specification. Inadequately tightened fuel pump connection could result in a fuel leak, which increases the risk of a vehicle fire.

What will Porsche do?

To remedy this issue, your Porsche Center will inspect your vehicle to help confirm that the high-pressure fuel pump is tightened to specification. If necessary, the high-pressure fuel pumps and fuel lines will be replaced. The remedy will be performed **at no charge to you** and will take approximately two days to complete, but it may be necessary to make your vehicle available to your Porsche Center for a longer period of time. Your Porsche Center will arrange for alternate transportation if necessary.

What should you do?

The remedy for this Recall is now available. Please contact any authorized Porsche Center to schedule an appointment to have this recall performed as soon as possible and to arrange for Porsche provided alternate transportation, if necessary.
