IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 25517

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2024 thru 2026 IC Bus™ CE Series school buses built 05/31/2023 thru 09/04/2025 equipped with air brakes (feature code 0004091) and an air dryer location mounted inside the engine compartment, right side (feature code 0004VLE).

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

When making a full right turn, the right, passenger-side tire may contact the air dryer discharge line.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Contact between the tire and air dryer discharge line may cause leaks that may prevent the system from maintaining adequate pressure as it is being consumed. If air pressure drops too low, this may cause the parking brakes to engage. Unintended engagement of the park brakes without driver input can increase the risk of a crash or personal injury.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve adding clipping points, rerouting the air line and replacing any damaged sections. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately one hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 05/31/2023 thru 09/30/2025. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
