Subject: Recall for inspection and replacement of VIN tag installed on 6X8GW2KPT model trailers

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Carry-On Trailer has decided that certain 2024, 2025 and 2026 6X8GW2KPT model trailers fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 567, "Certification". The investigation has revealed that due to an oversight during Carry-On Trailer's labeling process, the VIN tag on these trailers overstates the trailers GAWR. Affected trailers have axles consistent with a GAWR of 2,000 lbs. but the VIN tag lists the GAWR as 3,500 lbs. A trailer owner could misunderstand the trailer payload leading to possible trailer overload, increasing the risk of a crash. The Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GWVR) of your trailer is not affected by this recall.

Your trailer has been identified as one that is included in this recall. You are advised to replace the original trailer VIN tag with the corrected VIN tag following the work instructions included with this notification, free of charge. The remedy should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. If you had your trailer VIN tag replaced before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy for the problem associated with this recall.
