IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 25527

THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO YOUR VEHICLE IDENTIFIED ON THE ENCLOSED CARD.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2026 IC Bus™ CE Series commercial buses built 05/13/2025 with Q'Straint wheelchair securement feature code 0049HHK ([10] Track Tiedown Retractable)

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Retractor may not lock.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

An unlocked retractor will not properly secure a wheelchair and place the passenger at a risk of serious injury or death during normal vehicle travel, emergency maneuvers, or a crash.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve inspecting retractors for suspect lot codes and replacing them as necessary. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately an hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any Authorized repair center to have your vehicle repaired at no cost to you. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected this defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 05/13/2025 thru 02/28/2026. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
