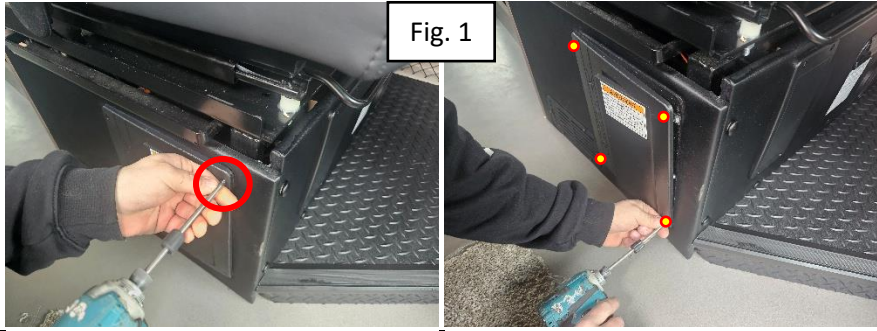

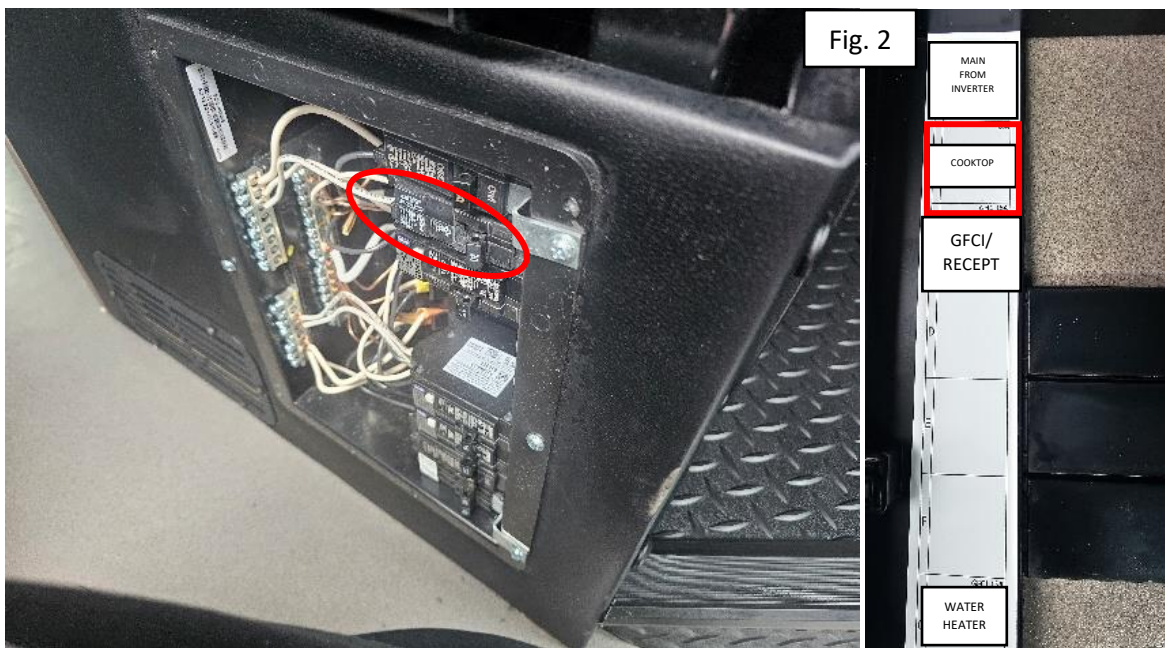

Ensure all power to the coach has been disconnected and the coach is powered off, prior to starting the repair.

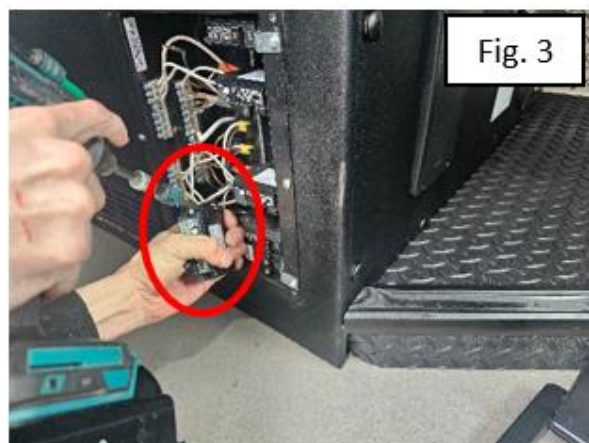
1. Use a screw gun and square head bit to remove the cover on the load center, there should be 4 fasteners . (Figure 1)



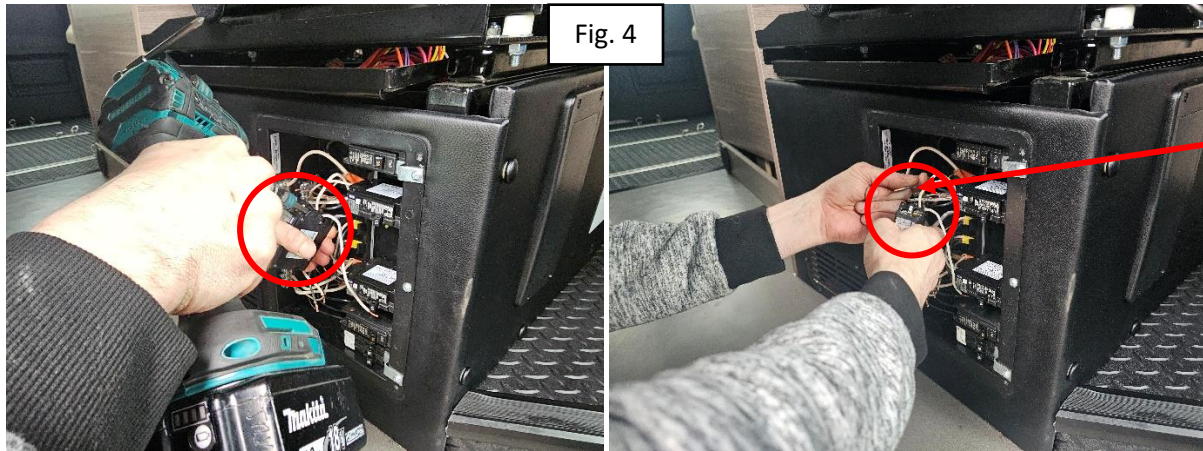
2. With the cover removed, identify the breaker for the "Cooktop". (Figure 2)
 - a. **Note: It should be the second breaker from the top of the load center. It will correspond to the decal attached to the load center lid.**



3. Use a flat blade bit to pop the breaker out of the housing.
4. With the breaker out, disconnect the existing Black wire. (Figure 3)

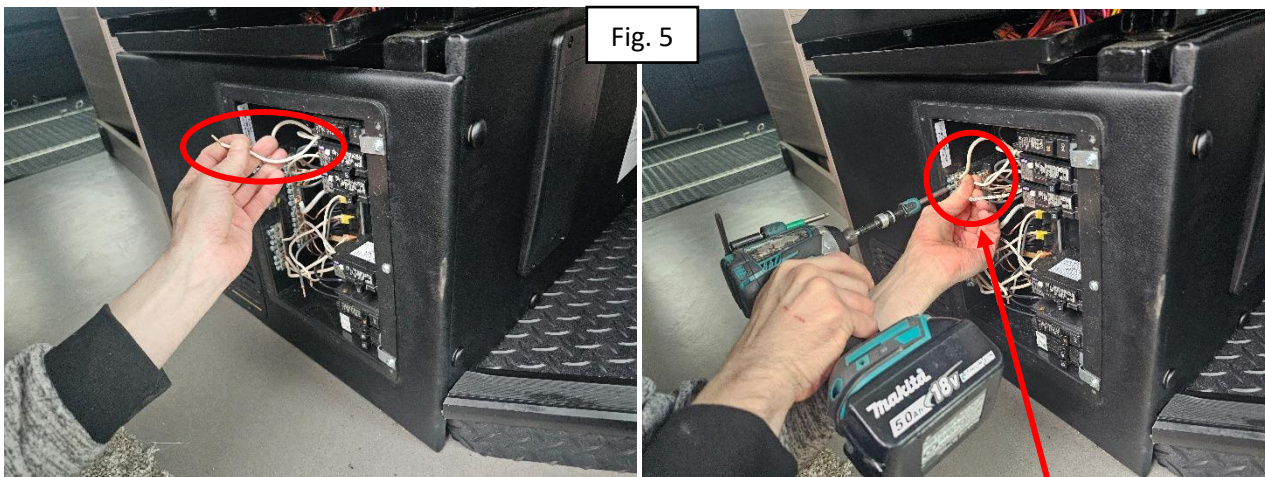


- ⚠ 5. Take the new GFCI breaker, unwind the white neutral wire, then connect the existing black wire to the new GFCI breaker.
- a. **Note: It is CRITICAL you torque this connection to 25IN-LBS.** (Figure 4)



6. Re-secure the breaker into the housing, in the load center, where the original was removed from.

- ⚠ 7. Tie the white neutral wire that was unwound, on the GFCI breaker, into the neutral bar.
- a. **Note: It is CRITICAL you torque this connection to 25IN-LBS** (Figure 5)



8. Replace the cover on the load center.
9. Place a new decal over the existing decal.
