RECALL R10329 DESCRIPTION

Volvo Cars USA LLC and Volvo Cars Canada LTD on behalf of the Volvo Car Corporation has decided to launch Recall R10329: BCM2 Software on certain model year 2025-2026 PHEV and BEV S60, V60, S90, XC60, XC90, EC40 and EX40 vehicles.

AND

On certain model year 2020-2024 PHEV and BEV S60, V60, XC60, XC90, XC40 and C40 vehicles that have had a replacement BCM2 module over their lifetime. These vehicles will be marked accordingly.

Volvo Car Investigations have determined that a loss of brake functionality may occur while in “B” drive mode on PHEV vehicles and “One Pedal Drive” mode on BEV vehicles after an extended coast down period. Affected customers may experience a loss of braking.

As a result, loss of brake functionality will increase the risk of a crash.

To remedy affected vehicles, Volvo Cars will perform a software upgrade.

A total of 11,469 U.S. and 1,986 Canadian vehicles are affected by this recall.
