Center Roof Marker Light Inoperative VN(4)

RECALL INFORMATION

(December 2025)

Volvo Trucks has determined that certain VN(4) model vehicles may be equipped with roof marker lights with non-conforming sockets. This can result in the center marker lamp connection failing resulting in insufficient luminosity. Marker lamps not illuminating may reduce visibility and increase the risk of a crash.

Volvo Trucks has not received any complaints or reports of vehicle crashes because of this safety defect; therefore, Volvo considers this as a proactive measure to protect the public and Volvo's customers from the potential risk associated with this defect.

To correct this safety issue, follow the instructions below to replace the center roof marker light.

VEHICLES AFFECTED

Certain Volvo North America VN(4) model vehicles manufactured between January 08, 2025, and May 30, 2025.

VEHICLE QUANTITY

There are 1,730 vehicles affected by this recall (1,465 U.S., 265 Canada).

Repair Instructions

1. Secure vehicle for service.
2. Follow Impact operation **3526-03-02-03 Position Light, replace (roof mounted)** to replace center roof marker light.
3. Release vehicle.
