

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

INTERIM OWNER NOTIFICATION

NHTSA Recall 25V-188

NOTIFICACIÓN PROVISIONAL AL PROPIETARIO

This notice applies to your vehicle, [VIN].

Dear Nissan Kicks Owner:

This interim notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that certain 2025 Model Year Nissan Kicks vehicles fail to conform to CFR 49 Part 567; "Certification." Within this affected population, Nissan has decided that certain Model Year 2025 Nissan Kicks SR vehicles equipped with optional 19-inch wheels fail to comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110; "Tire Selection and Rims." Our records indicate that you own or lease the Nissan vehicle subject to this recall as identified by the VIN on the inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

Motivo del Retiro

The Certification Label located on the driver's side door pillar near the door latch of your vehicle may contain incorrect Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) and Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) information required by the applicable regulation. Having the correct GVWR/GAWR information on the Certification label is important because overloading your vehicle may increase the risk of a crash.

Additionally, certain Model Year 2025 Nissan Kicks SR vehicles equipped with 19-inch wheel wheels may have the incorrect wheel and tire size information printed on the Certification Label. Adhering to the correct wheel and tire information on the Certification Label is important because under inflation can lead to low tire pressure and increase the risk of a crash.

What Nissan Will Do

Qué Hará Nissan

Nissan is finalizing the VIN-specific replacement Certification Label that contains the correct GVWR and GAWR values, and wheel and tire size information for your vehicle. This remedy is currently expected to be available next month, in June 2025. When the remedy is available, Nissan will send a final letter with your replacement Certification Label and include instructions on how to affix it.

What You Should Do

Qué Debes Hacer

Nissan recommends referencing the Tire and Loading Information label, adjacent to the Certification label, which contains the correct GVWR/GAWR and the 19-inch wheel and tire size information.
