INTERIM NOTICE

Dear Kia Sorento LX Vehicle Owner:

Kia has identified a defect in your vehicle which relates to motor vehicle safety.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Kia America, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 2021-2023 MY Sorento LX vehicles. The defect can result in a fire, increasing the risk of injury. Our records indicate that you own or lease one of the affected vehicles.

This is only an interim notice as we work on obtaining the remedy parts. The purpose of this notice is to keep you informed of Kia's recall implementation plan. **We will send you another letter when the remedy part is available** so that you can schedule a dealer appointment to have the recall repair performed free of charge at no cost to you. **IN THE MEANTIME, PLEASE SEE THE "WHAT SHOULD YOU DO IN THE INTERIM" SECTION BELOW.**

What Is The Problem?

Due to a wire harness quality issue, the connection between the blower motor resistor and connector can overheat when using the Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) system on fan speed 3 while the ignition is on. This condition may lead to a fire, increasing the risk of injury.

When The Remedy Parts Are Available, Kia Will Replace, As A Set, Both The Blower Motor Resistor Circuit Harness And the Blower Motor Resistor Free Of Charge At No Cost To You.

When the remedy parts are available, Kia dealers will replace, as a set, both the blower motor resistor circuit harness with an improved one and the blower motor resistor with a new one. This recall will be **performed free of charge at no cost to you.**

What Should You Do In The Interim?

- **WARNING:** The HVAC blower motor may become inoperable, or you may experience a burning or melting smell, and/or smoke coming from the air vents when using the HVAC system. **If you experience a burning or melting smell, and/or smoke coming from the air vents when using the HVAC system, pull over to a safe location and contact Kia Roadside Assistance at 1-800-333-4542 or online at kia.rsahelp.com to request to have your vehicle towed to the nearest authorized Kia dealership as soon as possible.**
- **When the remedy parts are available**, you will receive a follow-up letter advising you to contact an authorized Kia dealership to arrange for the recall to be performed on your vehicle.

QR Code Use:

- *A QR Code is a square, 2-dimensional barcode that can be read by mobile devices loaded with an appropriate barcode or QR Code Reader App. The app reads the barcode image and then launches/uploads the specific information the code contains, such as URLs, text, photos, videos.*
