WHY WE SENT THIS NOTICE:	<p>At the time this notice was mailed, our records show that online data collection was activated for your vehicle, and Audi's Online Field Monitoring program records show that one or more of the HV battery modules in your vehicle are NOT operating according to factory specifications.</p> <p><i>Audi will continue to retrieve and analyze data from the HV battery modules in your vehicle, as long as your vehicle is driven and Privacy Mode is not engaged.</i></p>
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:	<p><u>DO NOT</u> charge your vehicle from external sources until the recall remedy software becomes available.</p> <p>As a reminder, your vehicle owner's manual contains important information regarding your vehicle's warning lights and messages. We encourage you and anyone who drives your vehicle to review the owner's manual to become familiar with the types of vehicle indicators, warnings and messaging you may see.</p> <p>Your safety and that of your passengers is our highest priority.
