Pursuant to USC49CFR §577.13 – Notification to Dealerships and Distributors – Paragraph B

Forest River has decided that a safety defect exists in certain 2025 Catalina ACAT35FME Travel Trailer Recreational Vehicles. Forest River is recalling the defect model(s) to ensure the safety of our future retail consumers and your dealership. Forest River is issuing a Stop Sale Notice effective immediately.

WHAT IS THE DEFECT?

The Gross Vehicle Weight Rating "GVWR" printed on the FED Tag may be rated higher than the couplers load rating.

EVALUATION OF RISK:

The coupler may fail, which may increase the risk of property damage or a crash.

SERVICE PROCEDURE:
