REPAIR	A concern has been identified on certain 2023 model year Range Rover Evoque vehicles, where water may ingress into the rear-view camera. This water ingress can cause a distorted image, or no image at all to be displayed on the vehicle touchscreen. A blurred image or lack of display of the rear-view camera image may result in the driver being unaware of objects or pedestrians increasing the risk of an injury and/or a crash. Affected vehicles will require a replacement rearview camera.

CAMPAIGN LAUNCH	This recall repair bulletin was published November 3 rd 2025
NOTES	Retailers are required to hold all affected new vehicles in their inventory from sale until the repair is available and completed. Please refer to recall bulletin for instructions on used vehicles in retailer inventory. All affected VIN are flagged in the warranty portal and TOPIx. BBSS reporting for affected vehicles in retailer inventory is not yet available Due to a data error, some clients have received a mailing notification for this recall when their vehicle is not affected. Retailers are asked to ensure that, when making a repair appointment for this recall, the vehicle's eligibility for D053 is first checked in the warranty portal. A follow up communication was sent on Dec 10th, 2025, to all clients that have received a notification in error.
