SUBJECT: Recall 25-114-UUS / NHTSA Recall 25V223

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the Motor Vehicle Safety Act. This is to inform you that your school vehicle(s) may contain a defect that could affect the safety of a person.

Micro Bird has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2023-2024 school vehicles built on GM chassis.

In certain school vehicles equipped with supplemental suspension blades, the U-bolts holding them in place may break. If a U-bolt breaks, the pressure will no longer be evenly distributed, it can generate mechanical play and abnormal driving noises, damage nearby components or cause the axle to slip during sudden braking or acceleration. In extreme cases, the axle may detach from the chassis, causing loss of control, increasing the risk of crashing and if so, of injuries.

To complete this recall, owners will contact you to make an appointment to have their vehicle(s) corrected. They will identify the vehicle(s) to correct so you can determine, based on the "Inspection/Correction" column whether the U-bolts must be replaced ("Correction") or if they need to be inspected to decide whether correction is needed ("Inspection").

We request that you apply for reimbursement via the GOLS claim system with detailed invoices and a list of repaired vehicles so we can update our files.

Micro Bird Corporation will provide correction instructions and, if necessary, parts, as well as reimburse labor to mitigate this recall at no charge.

Consult the Inspection and Correction instruction documents to evaluate the allotted time to correct each vehicle, based on the "Inspection/Correction" information.

Important: We want to remind you that recalled vehicles must be corrected before you sell, lease, or deliver them; vehicles returned at the end of a lease must be corrected before they can be offered for sale as used vehicles.
