



## **STOP SALE AND DELIVERY – SAFETY RECALL**

**Subject: Stop Sale and Delivery for Upcoming Safety Recall**

**Affected Models:**

- 2022MY- 2026MY F-Series Vehicles  
Wholesaled prior to 9/13/2025

**To: Isuzu Dealer Principal, Sales Manager and Service Manager**

Effective immediately, stop the sale and delivery of affected vehicles in your inventory, even if a customer has purchased an affected vehicle. We are in the process of taking steps to address a safety related defect in these vehicles. **Federal law prohibits the sale and delivery to customers of any vehicle containing a safety defect. You must not deliver any covered vehicles to customers until after the vehicle has been remedied.**

**WHAT IS THE CONDITION?**

Isuzu Motors Limited has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, may exist in all 2022MY-2026MY F-Series vehicles wholesaled prior to 9/13/2025. In the affected vehicles, the fuel heater connector may, over time, become melted at the electrical connector and allow fuel to leak causing the vehicle to be difficult to start, or not start at all, and increasing the risk of a fire.

**WHAT WE WILL DO**

We are in the process of preparing a service procedure and procuring parts to remedy these vehicles. You will receive another notice regarding owner notification and campaign bulletin release as soon as the schedule is available.

**WHAT YOU SHOULD DO**

Confirm the affected vehicles in dealer inventory, open a repair order referencing this Stop Sale and hold the vehicles until further notification is received.
