Descriptive Information:

K&N determined the dates of manufacture of the fuel filters reported to have the non compliant O-ring by examining the shipping dates on the product received from the supplier. K&N determined the potential disintegration of the O-rings in the fuel filters began with the July 2025 shipments by testing batches of retained fuel filters for potential disintegration and reviewing Amazon reviews on when customers began leaving reviews discussing the disintegration. There are five impacted SKUs, all provided by the same supplier with the same defect: K&N 81-0300; K&N 81-0301; SPE-2369; SPE-2358; SPE-6932

Description of the defect or noncompliance:

The o-ring in the fuel filter may potentially disintegrate.

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26E048**Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:**

In some instances, if the o ring disintegrates, it could clog the fuel lines and cause engine performance issues or create a small leak in the fuel filter. If this were to occur, potential fuel system and engine contamination or performance issues could occur which could lead to a crash, or leaking fuel may create a fire risk.

Description of the cause:

K&N believes the cause of the defect may have been a change in the material by the component manufacturer used to manufacture the fuel filter o-rings.

Chronology

K&N has used this supplier for fuel filters for many years. On or about May 2026, K&N received 2 customer calls related to the o-ring disintegration. In June 2026, an additional notice was received by customer service. This prompted an immediate look into any additional claims or customer reviews, a discussion with the manufacturer, and a stop shipment. K&N also sent past held O-rings for testing to a third party, where it was discovered that under certain higher temperatures the o-rings were susceptible to disintegration within the fuel filter. It was noted that a few customers began posting reviews about the disintegration on or about November 2025 which aligned with the testing outcomes. Upon receipt of the third party testing, K&N immediately stopped shipments, alerted resellers to stop selling, and began to formalize a voluntary recall process.

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K&N will ask that customers immediately remove the fuel filter and replace it with the original fuel filter, or another one that is compatible with the vehicle. K&N will refund the purchase price of the recalled fuel filter, after that filter is returned to K&N with proof of its purchase. K&N will pay all shipping charges. At this time there is no replacement component being offered.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

K&N ceased shipments from this supplier of these components and has discontinued these SKUs.
