Description of the defect or noncompliance:

It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population may have insufficient securement of the 12-volt and 120-volt wires in the bedroom slide-out.

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

Under certain conditions during the operation of closing the bedroom slide out, the 12-volt and 120-volt wires may come in contact with a pinch point on the bed slide mechanism creating potential for an electrical fault leading to an increased risk of fire.

26V161**Description of the cause:**

The bedroom slide-out 12-volt and 120-volt wires may not be secured sufficiently enough to avoid potential pinch point contacts with the bed slide mechanism.

Identification of any warning that can occur:

Intermittent operation of lights or receptacles in the bedroom slide-out, tripped breakers, or visible signs of an electrical fault.
