Descriptive Information:

The basis for this recall is related to an error in transitioning the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating information into Shyft's ERP system at the time of receipt of the incomplete vehicle.

Defect / Noncompliance Description

Description of the defect or noncompliance:

The gross vehicle weight rating on the certification label is of a higher with value than what the vehicle is capable of carrying.

FMVSS1: 567 - Certification

FMVSS2:

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

If an operator of the vehicle were to follow the gross vehicle weight rating on the certification label, there is a potential to overload the tires. Overloading the tires could create a potential for a blow out which could increase the risk of a crash.

Still under investigation.

There is no warning associated with the non-compliance.

Chronology

On April 10, 2026, Product Safety and Compliance was made aware of a customer complaint involving the incorrect Gross Vehicle Weight Rating on a vehicle returned to one of our plants for service. A review of production records during the time frame was conducted to determine the potential scope of the problem. The affected population of vehicles was identified and on April 17, 2026, we determined a non-compliance could exist in those vehicles.

Shyft will supply new certification labels at no charge and instruct owners to install the new labels over the originally equipped labels.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

The new certification labels will have the corrected Gross Vehicle Weight Rating.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

A stop ship was placed on all vehicles on April 8, 2026 and information on the certification confirmed to be accurate and consistent with the incomplete vehicle label.
