Descriptive Information:

The recall population includes 32 Model Year 2026 Newmar Freedom Aire motorhomes produced before Newmar implemented a manual process to calculate and print the OCCC label. Vehicles produced after that containment action are not included because the OCCC label was calculated and printed using the corrected manual process."

Defect / Noncompliance Description

Description of the defect or noncompliance:

The affected vehicles may have an incorrect cargo carrying capacity value printed on the yellow OCCC label. As a result, the vehicles may not conform to FMVSS No. 120.

FMVSS1: 120 - Wheels and rims- other than passenger cars

FMVSS2:

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

An incorrect OCCC value may cause an owner to overload the vehicle. An overloaded vehicle may have

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reduced handling performance or exceed tire or axle load ratings, increasing the risk of a crash.

The software process used to generate the OCCC labels calculated an incorrect CCC value.

Chronology

In late February 2026, Newmar discovered that the software process used to generate yellow OCCC labels was printing an incorrect CCC value. Newmar immediately implemented a manual process to calculate and print OCCC labels and began investigating the cause and affected vehicle population. On April 21, 2026, Newmar's Brand Action Committee reviewed the potential safety concern and referred the matter to the Product Safety Committee. On April 22, 2026, the Product Safety Committee decided to conduct a noncompliance recall.

Newmar is not aware of any claims, injuries, crashes, or property damage related to this condition.

Description of Remedy

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Remedy Type: Replace

Consumer Advisories: Do Not Drive Park Outside

Description of remedy program:

Newmar will replace the OCCC label on each affected vehicle with a new label showing the correct CCC value, free of charge.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

Recalled remedy will be printing new OCCC labels with the correct CCC value, removing the incorrect label from the units in the population and installing new labels with the correct CCC value.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

After discovery, Newmar implemented a manual process to calculate and print OCCC labels. Vehicles labeled using the corrected manual process are not included in the recall. Newmar will continue using the corrected process until the software process is corrected and validated.

Reimbursement Plan

Newmar Corporation will conduct this recall free of charge.
