Chronology

May 4, 2026, Forest River's office of Corporate Compliance was notified of a concern that was discovered at the factory when changing an interior panel that had been damaged in manufacturing. When they removed the panel, they found the vent pipe was not plumbed all the way through the roof of the vehicle. The same day, the manufacturing plant notified OCC of concern; OCC opened a research item.

On May 11, 2026, Forest River's Corporate Committee voted to recall.

Description of remedy program:

Forest River will provide all parts and labor free of charge to Consumers and Dealers. An authorized Forest River dealer will need to perform the remedy of installing the appropriate plumbing vent pipe and roof cap.

What is the Forest River Customer Service Phone Number?

If you have already paid for a repair that is within the scope of this defect under recall, you still need to have this recall inspected and/or performed to ensure the correct parts and procedures were utilized. Additionally, you may be eligible for a refund of previously paid repairs. Refunds will only be provided for within the scope of this defect under recall.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

A vent pipe and roof vent cap will complete the plumbing system.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

On May 4, 2026, the manufacturing plant began fixing all vehicles in production and the holding yard that did not have the vent installed incorrectly.

Recall Schedule

Description of recall schedule:

Forest River has the utmost urgency in our recalls. Forest River will send suspected VIN numbers to our third-party vendor that is licensed to pull data on the current owner of the vehicles (as needed) once a formal NHTSA I.D. is provided. Forest River intends on pushing the mailing out as soon as NHTSA provides any correction(s) and an Acknowledgement Letter.
