Descriptive Information:

The affected population includes trailers equipped with potentially noncompliant rear impact guards. Wabash determined the population using manufacturing records and information from a supplier concerning a deviation from the torque specification for the bumper tube bolts.

Defect / Noncompliance Description

Description of the defect or noncompliance:

The bolts on the bumper tube portion of the subject trailers' rear impact guard (RIG) may not have been torqued by the supplier to the proper specification. As a result, the RIG may not conform to the performance requirements contained in FMVSS 223.

FMVSS1: 223 - Rear impact guards

FMVSS2:

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

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A rear impact guard that does not comply with FMVSS 223 may increase the risk of injury in the event of a rear impact by a trailing vehicle.

Description of the cause:

Following a change in the torque specification to accommodate the use of different metals for rear impact guard manufacturing, the supplier may not have tightened bolts to the updated torque values.

Chronology

- 5/27/2026 – In connection with a deviation request from Wabash's bumper tube supplier, Wabash learned that the supplier had previously been torquing the bolts below the required specification. The issue was referred to Wabash's Product Safety Team (PST) to evaluate the effect that the under-torqued bolts may have on compliance with FMVSS 223.
- 6/3/2026 – Wabash's PST met and began investigating the impact of the deviation.
- 6/5/2026 – The PST escalated the issue to the Product Safety Committee (PSC).
- 6/8/2026 - The PSC determined that the issue may result in a noncompliance with the performance requirements of FMVSS 223.

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Wabash is not aware of any accident or injury reports related to this condition.
