On June 15, 2026, Forest River's Office of Corporate Compliance was notified by the division of the discovered issue with the miss-labeled distribution panel. The same day a research item was opened.

On June 22, 2026, Forest River's Corporate Committee voted to recall.

Forest River will provide all parts and labor free of charge to Consumers and Dealers. An authorized Forest River dealer will need to perform the remedy to add the correct 110V circuit labels to the distribution panel.
