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Description of the defect or noncompliance:

Weight information listed on the Occupant and Cargo Carrying Capacity (OCCC) label is incorrect due to a weight scale malfunction. As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 120, "Wheels and Rims - Other than Passenger Cars."

FMVSS1: 120 - Wheels and rims- other than passenger cars

FMVSS2:

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

The OCCC label weight information being incorrect may cause the vehicle to be overloaded. An overloaded vehicle has an increased risk of a crash.

Description of the cause:

A weight scale malfunction in production caused the incorrect weight information to print on the Occupant and Cargo Carrying Capacity (OCCC) label.

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6/8/26: The Warranty Incident Review Committee (WIRC) met and discussed the incident and determined it should be elevated to Corrective and Preventive Action Committee (CPAC).

6/17/26: The Corrective and Preventive Action Committee (CPAC) met and decided to submit the incident to the Safety Steering Committee (SSC) for review and voting.

6/25/26: The Safety Steering Committee voted in favor of proceeding with a noncompliance recall for failing to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 120, "Wheels and Rims - Other than Passenger Cars." There have been one complaint and no warranty claims associated with this recall.
