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Chronology

06/17/2026 Tiffin Motorhomes was contacted by Airxcel and informed they had decided a safety defect existed in the MaxxAir fans due to the possibility the printed circuit board could overheat and may cause a fire. Airxcel asked that Tiffin hold all units equipped with a MaxxAir fan while they were finalizing the details of issue and repair. A block was issued to prevent shipping any motorhomes equipped with the fan while waiting for more information from Airxcel. 06/19/2026 Representatives arrived at Tiffin and repairs began to suspect fans in Tiffin's warehouse stock. 06/22/2026 Production was provided with updated fans to be used in production and repairs to all motorhomes already in the process of production began. 06/24/2026 Tiffin's safety committee met and reviewed the information available from Airxcel. Based on the safety defect filed by Airxcel, a safety recall will be filed to include all units from January 12, 2026, through June 19, 2026.

Description of remedy program:

Dealers will be instructed to replace the existing defective circuit board in the MaxxAir fan with an updated circuit board for all motorhomes involved in the recall.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

Remedied PC boards will feature a clear oval sticker with black text stating "Q.C.PASSED". Remedied fans will feature a white circle sticker with purple text stating "QUAL INSP". Boxes containing remedied fans will have a purple circle sticker with no text.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

The PC boards were modified to address the thermal issue. All boards used in production beginning 06/22/2026 will have the corrections completed.

Reimbursement Plan

Manufacturer used general reimbursement plan on file.

Recall Schedule

Description of recall schedule:

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Tiffin Motorhomes will mail letters to customers and dealers that are in possession of the involved motorhomes explaining the issue and asking them to take the motorhome to a dealer or a service center so the PC boards on the involved fans can be replaced. This will be done at no cost to the owner.
