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The printed circuit board (PCB) installed in the MaxxFan assembly contains a defect that can result in overheating during certain operations.

FMVSS1:**FMVSS2:****Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:**

If thermal activity were to occur, it may cause a fire, increasing the risk of personal injury and/or property damage.

Description of the cause:

Capacitance on the field-effect transistors (FET) is insufficient to handle the current flow which results in device failure and heat build up.

Identification of any warning that can occur:

Smoke will be present if the PC board is experiencing a thermal event.

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Chronology

6/23/2026 - Airxcel technician arrived at production facility and advised that the fans used in production are affected by an upcoming recall and requested authorization to repair them. GDRV puts a hold on unshipped units while further information is gathered. GDRV allows technician to repair production stock and unshipped units.

6/30/2026 - Airxcel provides their OEM notification to GDRV officially advising of recall.

7/1/2026 - GDRV reviews purchase orders and determines that affected parts have been used in production.

7/1/2026 - GDRV reviews warranty data to determine if any claims have been submitted. As of 6/30/2026 GDRV has not had any thermal events or PCB failures on the fans in question.

7/6/2026 - Grand Design's Safety Committee meets and votes to recall.

Description of remedy program:

The remedy will be to inspect the fan and if it contains the suspect PC board, the PC board will be replaced.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

Remedied PC boards will feature a clear oval sticker with black text stating "Q.C. PASSED". Remedied fans will feature a white circle sticker with purple text stating "QUAL INSP". Packages containing remedied fans will feature a purple circle sticker with no text.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

The PC boards were modified to address the thermal issue. All boards used in production beginning 06/24/2026 will have the corrections completed.
