Winnebago Industries has decided that certain 2027 Winnebago View and Navion are equipped with a printed circuit board (PCB) installed in the MaxxAir Fan assembly that contains a defect that can result in overheating during certain operations.

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

If thermal activity were to occur, it may cause a fire, increasing the risk of personal injury and/or property damage.

Description of the cause:

Capacitance on the field-effect transistors (FET) is insufficient to handle the current flow which results in device failure and heat buildup.

Identification of any warning that can occur:

Smoke will be present if the PC board is experiencing a thermal event.
