Defect / Noncompliance Description

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Description of the defect or noncompliance:

The tire information label applied to the subject vehicles states a recommended cold inflation pressure for the rear tires that exceeds the maximum cold inflation pressure of the tires installed on the vehicle. The label states 100 psi. The correct value for the installed LT295/65R20 tires is 80 psi. The label therefore does not state a recommended cold inflation pressure appropriate for the installed tires as required by S5.3.1 of FMVSS No. 120 (49 CFR 571.120).

FMVSS1: 120 - Wheels and rims- other than passenger cars

FMVSS2:

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

Sustained operation of an over-inflated tire increases the risk of tire failure, and a rear tire failure at highway speed on a motor home increases the risk of loss of vehicle control and a crash.

Description of the cause:

During processing of the change orders, the tire size designation and the front axle inflation value were updated in the label data source. The rear axle inflation value was not updated and retained the base configuration value of 100 psi. Labels printed from that record and applied at production accordingly state 100 psi for the rear axle.

Identification of any warning that can occur:

The condition may not be detectable by the operator. The incorrect value appears on the label the operator is directed to rely on, and an owner following normal pre-trip tire inspection practice may over-inflate the tire.

Grand Design has received no field reports, warranty claims, property damage claims, injuries, or fires associated with this condition.

05/20/26 - Dealer notifies GDRV customer service of concern.

05/26/26 - Grand Design confirms label mismatch.

05/26/26 - It was determined that a process issue with optional tire configuration was identified

05/29/26 - Job code M920036 created to notify dealers and flag affected units and to provide trackability of replaced labels.

07/08/26 - Grand Design audit for this condition determines there were 2 retailed units affected and a decision is made to escalate to Brand Action Committee

07/15/26 - Brand Action Committee reviews the matter and escalates it to the Product Safety Committee.

07/22/26 - The Product Safety Committee decides that a noncompliance exists in the subject vehicles and directs a recall.

Description of remedy program:

Grand Design will replace the nonconforming tire information label with a corrected label stating a recommended cold inflation pressure of 80 psi. The repair will take no more than 20 minutes

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

The new PSI stickers have accurate information populated.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

Software was reconfigured to ensure that when change orders are processed the information is accurate. Along with that physical inspection of every tag is now occurring prior to installation.
