On or about July 14, 2026, Wanco Inc. received a customer report of a Diesel Light Tower trailer with a reported fuel leak at the fuel tank. Wanco Inc. requested tank to be returned to Wanco Inc. for evaluation.

On or about July 28, 2026, based on evaluation of existing data and consideration of potential safety risks, Wanco Inc. decided to conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the fuel tanks on the affected trailers. There have been no reported fires or injuries to date.
