Certain PowerView 700 displays may become unresponsive at times, causing an inability to activate emergency lighting and/or emergency equipment.

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

A loss of exterior lights can reduce visibility to other drivers, increasing the risk of a crash. Inoperative equipment can delay emergency response, increasing the risk of injury.

Description of the cause:

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This loss of responsiveness is caused by faulty programming in certain PowerView 700 panels.

This unresponsiveness will occur with no prior warning.

08/04/2026 - Halcore was notified by NHTSA that Weldon listed them as an affected manufacturer on recall 26E020.

08/07/2026 - It was discovered that Halcore did have an affected population with defective Weldon components installed and it was decided that Halcore would file its own 573 in order to pass through the Weldon 26E020 recall.

08/10/2026 - 8/13/2026 - and investigation was performed in order to compile a complete affected suspect population.

08/14/2026 - The 573 was filed.

Description of Remedy

Description of remedy program:

Weldon will arrange the installation of an Enovation Controls Inc firmware update to remedy the touch issue found on this population of screens and the installation of a Class1 watchdog to make sure the Enovation screen starts up. Vehicle OEMs who have installed this equipment will have recall document directed to them as they are the purchasers of this product, and vehicle owners will receive the remedy. To clarify, the remedy involves updating the Enovation firmware that runs the screens and adding a watchdog that makes sure the screen starts up.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

The remedy components will have a decal applied after the Enovation firmware is installed. The second part of the remedy, the Class1 watchdog is visibly installed behind the screen and is visually obvious and this will be shown in the remedy installation instructions.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

On Weldon's side, production shipments stopped when the recall population was identified and production shipments will resume with the remedy installed April 30.
On Halcore's side, a stop ship has been implemented on all vehicles with defective units installed until the remedy can be implemented.
