Re: **EXPANSION-Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2024 Integra Driver's Seat Lift Link Bolt Loose**

On January 29, 2026, Acura notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for 6 units of model year 2024 Integra. During manufacturing, a bolt in the driver's seat cushion frame assembly may have been improperly torqued. An improperly manufactured seat frame may not hold the seat in position during a collision, preventing the occupant from being properly restrained, increasing the risk of injury. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Replace the driver's seat cushion frame.

PARTS

Parts will be available at launch via the normal parts ordering process.

TOOLS

There are no new special tools needed for this campaign.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 26-006, *Safety Recall: 2024 Integra Driver's Seat Lift Link Bolt Loose* posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of January 30, 2026. It includes repair, parts, and warranty claim information related to this recall.

CLIENT NOTIFICATION

Acura expects to begin client notification in early March 2026.
